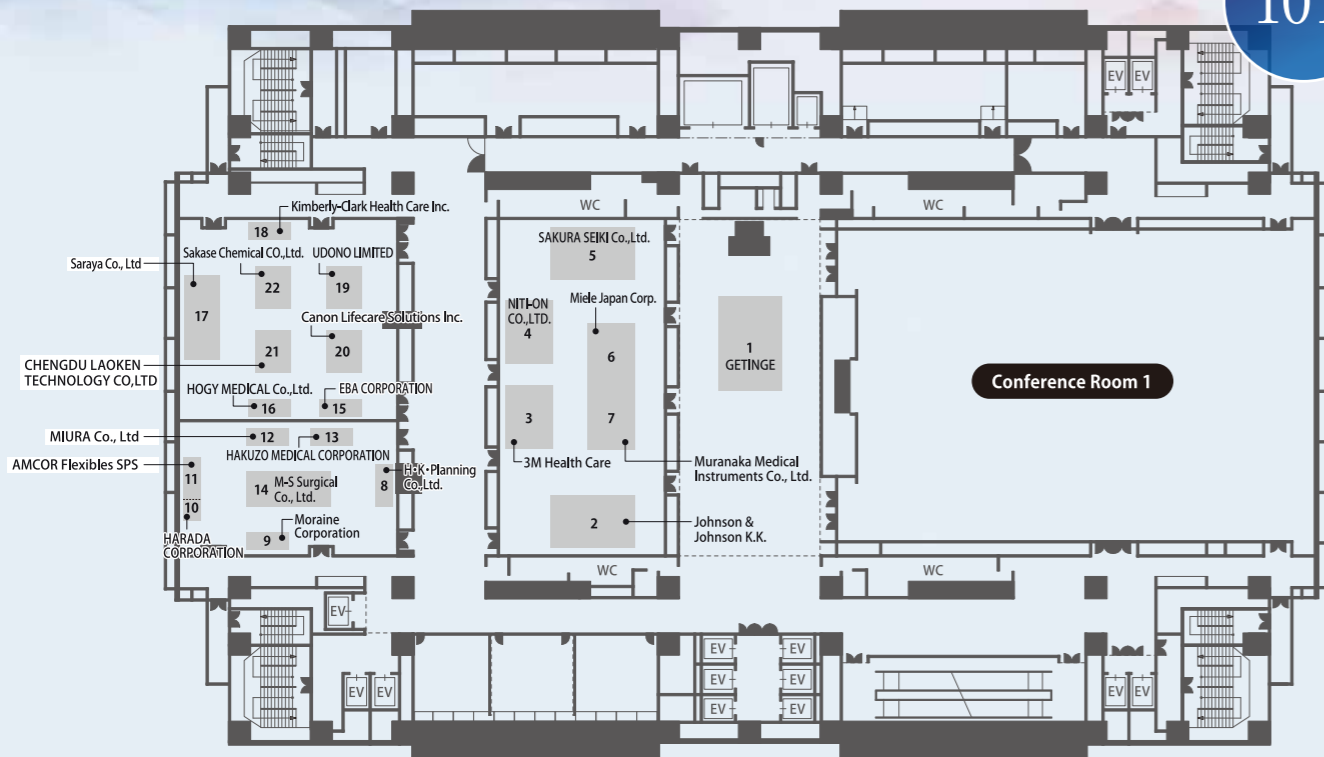


# WFHSS Exhibition Floor Plan

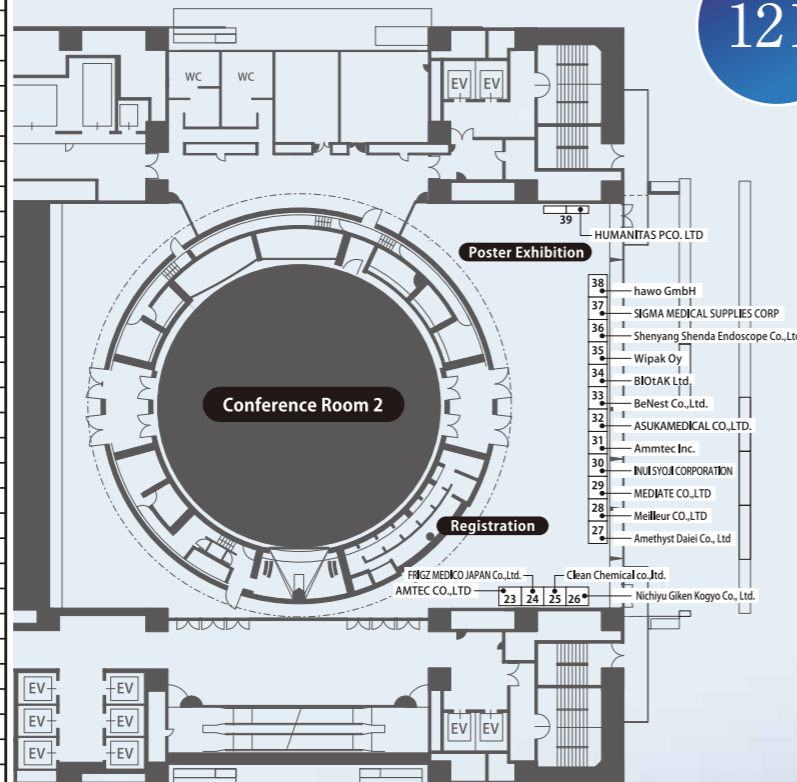

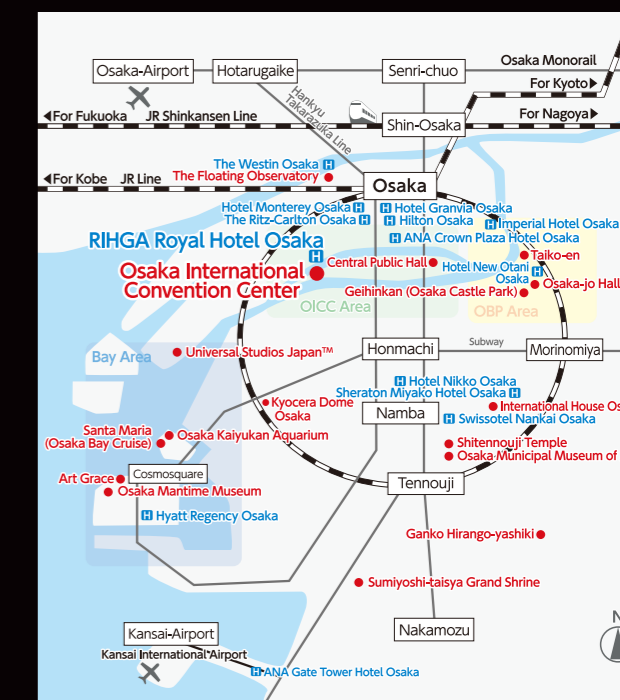

## Convenient Access to Major Cities

Reaching Osaka is easier than ever. With Kansai International Airport (KIX), Osaka is connected with 70 cities in 28 countries and regions around the world.  
As the second most important airport in Japan, KIX was ranked 4th in the 2006 World's Best Airports. The airport is conveniently accessible to downtown Osaka within about half an hour by train.

Located approximately in the center of Japan, Osaka is connected to major cities around the nation. Kansai International Airport, Osaka International Airport and Shin-Osaka Station for Bullet Train as well as a web of public transportation network, Osaka is easily accessible from/to almost all the major cities within at most two hours.



## Access to the venue

### Shuttle Bus

Guests may use shuttle bus service between RIHGA ROYAL HOTEL and the JR Osaka Station west side (under the overhead structure).

### By Train From

- Go to Namba station via the Nankai Railway Express train.
